By the time this goes to press we will already be in the thralls of our Lenten season. Lent, as well as many of our Catholic Holy Days and Seasons, find us performing many traditional rites. The three main traditions for lent are fasting, prayer and alms giving. Another tradition and one of my favorites is our Friday evening Stations of the Cross.

Whether presiding or praying and walking the stations, I find the experience both spiritual and enlightening. Spiritual because we examine up close the events that brought about our salvation and enlightening because of those who attend and share this experience with one another. As we progress through each station and recite the scripture and prayers associated with them, I begin to put myself into each situation, standing in disbelief at Pilate's decision, walking along side and sharing His heavy burden, being comforted by Him throughout the entire ordeal, kneeling heartbroken and sorrowful with Mary at the foot of the cross and finally placing Him in the tomb with the certainty that He will rise in glory. While the Stations of the Cross may show Christ alone in his suffering we know, understand and believe that he carries each of us in His sacred heart.


