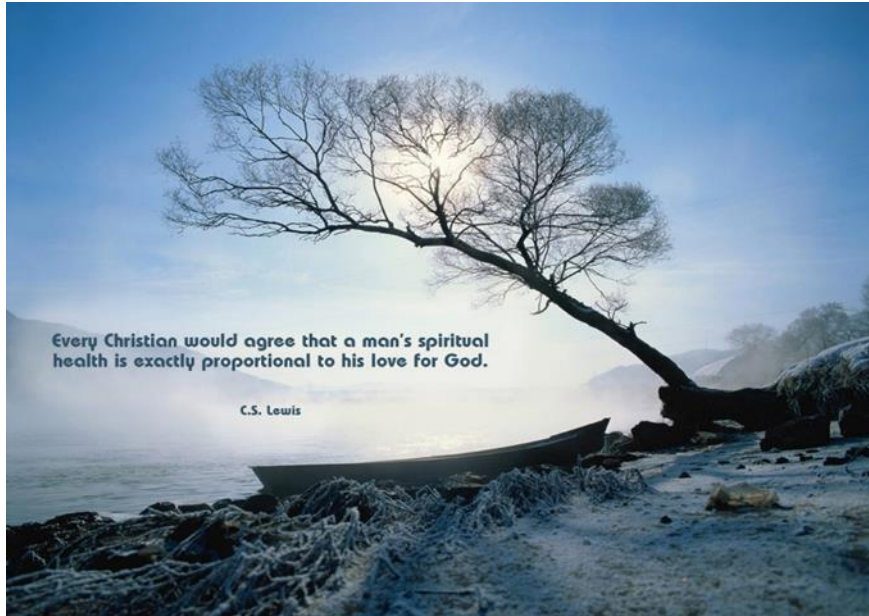
Chancellor's Report
